

13.16.15 Emergency Response

Respondent Comment

Queensland Police Service states that the EIS should include reference to QPS with outline of roles and responsibilities as incident command and investigation.

Queensland Police Service should be engaged as an Agency Stakeholder in the development of the Emergency Response Plan (ERP). The appropriate contact is the District Officer, Gladstone Police District.

The EIS should also detail the connection between the nominated legislation, responsibilities and Emergency Response Plans as well as specific Environmental Management Plans for GLNG.

Santos Response

The CSG fields, gas transmission pipeline and LNG facility EMPs have been updated with the following text:

Emergency Response Plan

Santos will ensure engagement with QPS and other agencies in Emergency response exercises.

Respondent Comment

Queensland Police Service requested that the LNG manager engage QPS in development of security plans ensures consistency with QPS objectives and core responsibilities in so far as counter terrorism and criminal act response and investigation is concerned. This engagement should extend to detailed discussions of the role of Gladstone District Water Police and proponent expectations regarding safety exclusion zones.

Queensland Police Service requested that it should be engaged and included in desktop or other planning and response exercise related to security and incident/emergency management. (See Port of Brisbane Emergency Plan and Security Plan).

Santos Response

Santos has already consulted with QPS in the drafting of current security risk assessments for facilities on Curtis Island, and project activities relating to the gas transmission pipeline and the CSG fields. All future

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security plans developed by Santos and the EPC contractor will include detailed consultation with the relevant State and Federal agencies responsible for security, law enforcement and emergency management. This will ensure appropriate alignment with local response arrangements.

Santos will also ensure engagement with QPS and other agencies in emergency response exercises. This engagement will be reflected in the emergency management exercise schedule for both Santos and the EPC contractor.

The CSG fields, gas transmission pipeline and LNG facility EMPs have been updated with the following text:

Emergency Response Plan

- The emergency response plan shall include information outlining the connection to relevant legislation as well as specific GLNG Project EMPs.
- Santos will ensure engagement with QPS and other agencies in emergency response exercises.
