





## 2. Structure of the AEIS

This Chapter outlines the structure of the AEIS, which has been designed to provide some background on the purpose and scope of the AEIS and to provide responses to the additional information requested through the public submission process. The AEIS fundamentally contains seven Chapters with associated Appendices as described below.

Chapter 1 - Introduction: provides:

- an overview of the revised Project;
- the EIS process under which the revised Project is to be assessed;
- an outline of the purpose of the AEIS;
- and an update on the stakeholder consultation and public notification activities that have occurred since the release of the draft EIS; and
- an evaluation of submissions received on the draft EIS and an overview on the genesis of the AEIS.

Chapter 2 - Outline of the structure of the AEIS,

**Chapter 3** – Outline of the changes to the revised Project that have occurred since the release of the draft EIS and outline of changes, updates or additions to the information provided in the draft EIS, now provided as part of the AEIS report

**Chapter 4** – Project approvals: detail of approvals and associated legislation for off-lease infrastructure.

Chapter 5 – Responses to Submissions: contains detailed responses that address:

- Further information requested by the Coordinator-General, which also included key issues requiring further information, which relates to issues raised by members of the public and organisations in submissions on the draft EIS;
- the issues raised by each Advisory Agency's submission; and
- the issues raised by private submissions and organisation's submissions.

Chapter 6 – Errata: provides corrections to errors made in the draft EIS.

**Chapter 7** – References: provides a list of references that were used in the preparation of this AEIS in either author format or website location.

**Appendices A** to **O** include Appendices that have been amended or added as supporting documentation to the AEIS, due to corrections or updates or additions made to the information provided in the draft EIS.
