## 1 LNG COMPONENT - ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

Draft Environmental Management Plans (EMP) for construction and operation of the LNG Facility were provided as *Volume 11* of the Queensland Curtis LNG (QCLNG) Project draft environmental impact statement (EIS). The content of these EMPs will continue to be revised through stakeholder consultation, as well as ongoing refinement of Project construction planning and detailed design. Final EMPs will be issued as part of QGC's application for an environmental authority to conduct *Chapter 5* activities following the setting of Project by the Coordinator General.

As the draft EMPs will remain the subject of negotiations with regulators, and as no major changes to most of the draft EMPs have been made following submission of the draft EIS, the EMPs as submitted in the draft EIS have not been reproduced here. However, ongoing planning for construction has resulted in further development of four draft Construction Phase EMPs / management strategies. Drafts of these are included as Appendices to this volume, and are tabulated in *Table 11.1.1* below. Note that as for EMPs submitted with the draft EIS, these will continue to be developed and refined prior to finalisation before commencement of construction activity on the LNG Facility site.
