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Background

The Shute Harbour Marina project: Coordinator-General's evaluation report on the environmental impact statement (CGER) was released in December 2013, pursuant to section 35 of the State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971 (SDPWO Act) in force at 3 May 2013.

On 14 December 2018, the proponent applied to the Coordinator-General to evaluate a proposed change to the Shute Harbour Marina project, under Division 3A, section 35C of the SDPWO Act.
