Background

The South of the Embley Project – Coordinator-General's report on the environmental impact statement (Coordinator-General's report) was released in May 2012, pursuant to section 34D(4) of the State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971 (Qld) (SDPWO Act).

On 28 September 2015, the proponent applied to the Coordinator-General to assess proposed changes to the South of the Embley Project, under Division 3A, section 35C of the SDPWO Act.

On 9 October 2015, the Coordinator-General decided to publicly notify the request for project change. Public notification occurred during the period 14 October – 28 October 2015. No public submissions were received on this request for project change.

In accordance with section 35H of the SDPWO Act, the Coordinator-General has evaluated the environmental effects of the proposed change, its effect on the project and any other related matters, and prepared this Coordinator-General's change report under section 35I of the SDPWO Act.

- (IV) Before commencement of operations, develop the Housing and Accommodation Master Plan in consultation with the Department of Housing and Public Works and relevant local stakeholders as stated in the SIMP.
- (v) Include relevant housing mitigation and management strategies in future revisions of the SIMP and report on their implementation via the SIMP progress reports.

- (v) Before commencement of operations, develop the Housing and Accommodation Master Plan in consultation with the Department of Housing and Public Works and relevant local stakeholders as stated in the SIMP.
- (vi) Include relevant housing mitigation and management strategies in future revisions of the SIMP and report on their implementation via the SIMP progress reports.
